



Sharing our learning & playing activities



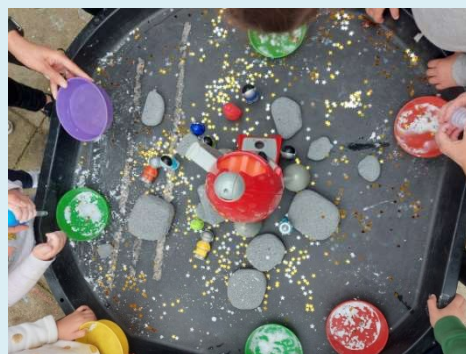
We talked and learnt about **Oral hygiene** reading books. We practiced brushing our **teeth**, learning when/where to brush our teeth and the importance of how we can look after them.



Children worked as a team to build their own space centre, deciding where best to position the **rocket** and discussed how **astronauts** have special rules to follow to keep them safe in space.



We all enjoyed learning about **Space**. The names of the planets, their sizes, gravity, we sang space rhymes, made moon rocks and used black shiny play dough to build aliens. We had lots of **laughter** pretending to be in space! We also enjoyed listening to space story books.



We made bubbling **planets** by mixing vinegar, baking soda, water and by using eye droppers - it was so much fun **experimenting** with different elements!!



We visited our field, **exploring** different **tress** in our surroundings. Learning their names, helping each other match trees to our nature guide, experiencing different colours of leaves the smell, texture, shapes and size. We then made paintings using leaves.
