Graduated Support

We have three stages of Graduated Support

Level One - Supporting high-quality teaching, reasonable adjustments and simple resources to help children develop. These include:

- Movement breaks
- Sensory activities
- Access to calm, safe space
- Access to pictures to show activities and order of the day
- Makaton supported communication for all

Level Two - If the above is not sufficient an assessment plan is worked on looking at:

- Meet the parents/carers
- Identify the specific need
- Develop a targeted support plan
- Develop expected outcomes
- Implement the support
- Measure the impact
- Revise as necessary

Level Three - Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)

If a child is not meeting expected developmental milestones the following is implemented:

- Engagement with parents/carers to open communications
- Visual aids
- Structured routines
- Small-group activities
- Supportive communication strategies

Some children may need an EHCP. This is a legally binding document developed through a local authority assessment. It outlines the child's needs and the support they should receive.

Bromley Early Years Inclusion Team offer early intervention support for children 0-4 years old. These services work with families and settings to promote inclusion.

Local Support for parents - Bromley Parent Carer Forum (BPCF)

1. A locally based group of parent carers of children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND), dedicated to amplifying families' voices and influencing service provision in Bromley

2. This forum provides:

- A free membership to all Bromley-based parent carers
- Collect input from families via surveys, coffee mornings, polls, working groups, webinars and conferences
- Use a "you said, we did" approach ensuring feedback leads to visible progress
- Partnerships and influence Part of the National Network of Parent Carer Forums, engage in local governance SEND governance board, Local offer panels, interviews for Local Offer roles
